DRESS CODE

Females & Males

- 1 Jewelry and makeup are not allowed.
- 2 No offensive writing shall be on clothing.
- 3 No tight or form fitting clothing is allowed.

Females

- 1 No sleeveless or cap sleeved tops are allowed.
- 2 All hem lines must be below the knee when sitting, standing, and at all times (and be the longestvisible layer of clothing).
- 3 Low neck lines are not allowed...(No lower than two fingers below the clavicle bone)
- 4 Shorts, slacks, pantsuits, culottes, or split skirts are not allowed.

Males

- 1 No sleeveless shirts or tank tops are allowed.
- 2 Button up shirts must remain buttoned all the way up except for the collar button.
- 3 All males must be clean cut. (No hair hanging over the ears or below the collar)

Special Rule Allowance

Other Rules and Regulation may be added by the camp director as he deems necessary.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1 Each person is expected to keep his or her own area in the dorm and tabernacle clean.
- 2 Each person is expected to accept his assigned duties during camp.
- 3 Each person is expected to be in bed with the lights out at the specified time.
- 4 All campers must remain in the tabernacle until dismissed from the pulpit by camp staff.
