REGISTRATION STEPS

1 • Register online at BluegrassPentecostal.com (Registration will be live on or around May 31st)

Registration is only available online. Registrations are non-refundable.

2 • Following your online registration, please print the required forms in this PDF (**Dress Code, Medical Release**) and the **group leader must bring the signed copies to check-in on the first day of Youth Camp**. The signed medical release form is required for each attendee (If the attendee is under 18, the form must be signed by a parent or guardian).

3 • **Background Check:** Due to regulations, all attendees aged 18+ that are staying on the campgrounds (Including in RV/Camper-Trailer) will be required to have a background check. We will contact you soon to process the background check on anyone in your group aged 18+.

4 • **Check In:** Check-in will be from 12:00 PM - 2:00 PM on Monday the first day of Youth Camp. Upon arriving, your group must check-in at the cafeteria (First building on the left).

Be sure to have all Medical Release and Dress Code forms signed, filled out and ready to be turned in by your group leader at check-in.

- 1 • All persons staying on grounds must be registered.
- 2 • Registered persons may not leave the grounds/campus without permission from Camp Deans.
- 3 • Registered persons must attend all services.
- 4 • Electronic audio, video or recording devices are strictly prohibited in dorms.
We strongly encourage campers to leave their cell phones at home.
Should a camper bring a cell phone to camp, they must abide by the following rules:
*Phones must be given and kept by counselors as soon as camper arrives at camp and remain with counselor until leaving campgrounds. *Should a camper need to use a cell phone to call home, they must do so in the presence of their counselor with no exceptions being made. *If a camper is caught with a phone in their possession in the dorm, they will be sent home immediately. This is prohibited and will be enforced with no exceptions being made. (This is to protect the personal privacy of our youth.)
*Bluegrass Pentecostal Young Camp Officers and Staff are not liable for loss and/or damage of personal property which includes cell phones.
- 5 • The use of alcoholic, drugs, smoking or tobacco products is prohibited.
- 6 • Absolutely No Boys are allowed in Girl's Dorms,
and No Girls are allowed in Boy's Dorms.
- 7 • Dating couples are to remain in open areas at all times
and physical contact will not be tolerated.
- 8 • Guns, knives, fireworks or weaponry of any sort is prohibited.
- 9 • Chewing Gum is not allowed.

Females & Males

- 1 • Jewelry and makeup are not allowed.
- 2 • No offensive writing shall be on clothing.
- 3 • No tight or form fitting clothing is allowed.

Females

- 1 • No sleeveless or cap sleeved tops are allowed.
- 2 • All hem lines must be below the knee when sitting, standing, and at all times (and be the longest-visible layer of clothing).
- 3 • Low neck lines are not allowed...(No lower than two fingers below the clavicle bone)
- 4 • Shorts, slacks, pantsuits, culottes, or split skirts are not allowed.

Males

- 1 • No sleeveless shirts or tank tops are allowed.
- 2 • Button up shirts must remain buttoned all the way up except for the collar button.
- 3 • All males must be clean cut. (No hair hanging over the ears or below the collar)

Special Rule Allowance

Other Rules and Regulation may be added by the camp director as he deems necessary.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1 • Each person is expected to keep his or her own area in the dorm and tabernacle clean.
- 2 • Each person is expected to accept his assigned duties during camp.
- 3 • Each person is expected to be in bed with the lights out at the specified time.
- 4 • All campers must remain in the tabernacle until dismissed from the pulpit by camp staff.
- 5 • **THOSE WHO DO NOT COMPLY WITH ALL CAMP RULES ARE SUBJECT TO DISMISSAL.**
